 - What criteria must you meet in order to apply?
 - Be a U.S. citizen, national or permanent resident.
 - Finish your certificate or degree program after Sept. 1 of the year in which scholarship applications are due.
 - Be an ASRT member.
 - Financial assistance is available

 - For entry-level scholarships only, be enrolled in an accredited radiologic science program with at least one semester of radiologic studies (not prerequisites) completed with a minimum program GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, **and** be an ASRT member in good standing.
 - For professional-level scholarships only, have applied to or currently attend an accredited degree or certificate program **and** be an ASRT member.
